Quakertown Alive! is celebrating over 25 years in downtown Quakertown and invites local storefront businesses – including national and regional franchises - to participate. Your participation in this event is an opportunity to spread your organization's message to over 7,000 people from the Upper Bucks County area and beyond. We have expanded our marketing to include the Lehigh Valley and the greater Tri-County area to increase the number of festival attendees.

Applications will be reviewed in a timely manner by a representative of the Events Committee. Vendors will receive confirmation emails. Please refer to the table below to determine your vendor fee. The fee for electric, if needed, is an additional \$15, which will be non-refundable. Checks should be made payable to Quakertown Alive!. There is a \$25 fee for returned checks due to insufficient funds. If your application is accepted, your entry fee will be processed, otherwise your check will be returned to you. **Only one vendor is permitted per space**.

Our rain date is Sunday, May 18, 2025 from 10 am to 4 pm. If you cancel and do not attend the rain date, you **will not** receive a refund. In the event that <u>both</u> dates need to be canceled by Quakertown Alive!, we will refund half the vendor fees upon request by letter with a self-addressed stamped envelope within 30 days. Any monies not requested to be refunded will be considered a donation to the programs of Quakertown Alive!, a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization.

Spaces are in the street, <u>do not</u> block the sidewalk. The display area assigned to accepted entrants must be manned throughout the entire show. The accepted applicant must provide his/her own canopy, table, tent weights, and display. Be prepared for an outdoor event, including wind gusts and fluctuating weather. Tents/canopies MUST be secured. QA! will have a designated safety officer walking around the event to check on tent weights.

- 1. Quakertown Alive! reserves the right to accept or deny any vendor application.
- 2. The event committee will assign space location to the vendors. The committee can take special requests into consideration, but there is NO guarantee. Space assignments are final.
- 3. All vendors are required to remain open during the entire length of the event.
 - Arts Alive! 10:00 AM 4:00 PM
- 4. Vendors must adhere to the set-up times. NO early birds.
 - Arts Alive! set up begins at 7:30 AM. Vendors must be set up by 9:30 AM.
 - Food trucks may start entering at 7:30 AM. Food trucks must be parked by 9:00 AM.
- 5. Vendors may request an electric hookup. There is an additional \$15 cost for the electric hookup. Vendors MUST bring their own electrical cords.
 - There are a limited number of electric hookups available. Spaces are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.
- 6. It is the sole responsibility of each accepted vendor to obtain any and all required, applicable, and appropriate state and local licenses/ permits needed. Each vendor also bears the sole responsibility for payment of all taxes pertaining to their operation.
- 7. All structures and sundries (tents, tables, chairs, trash cans, weights, etc.) are to be supplied by the vendor and are the responsibility of the vendor. All tents must be secured with weights to withstand changing weather conditions. QA! will have a Designated Safety Officer walking the event to check on tent weights.
- 8. Vendors agree to assume all liability for and agree to indemnify and hold harmless all organizations and persons sponsoring, managing or in any other way participating in the Arts Alive! Festival, including, but not limited to Quakertown Alive! and its personnel and Quakertown Borough from any seen or unseen injury, theft, or other loss to any person or property incurred by them or their representatives during travel to/ from, load in/ set up, event, and break down, claim, penalty, or lawsuit in any way arising from operation or involvement in the Arts Alive! festival.
